ABOUT US

The Federation of Chinese Canadians in Markham (FCCM) is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to the provision of services to the Chinese community and the integration of Chinese Canadians into the mainstream of Canada. Established in 1989, FCCM was formally incorporated on may 22, 1992. It is managed by a volunteer board of directors.

Since its establishment, FCCM has been actively working towards its goals through a variety of social, cultural, and business activities, not only to assist Chinese Canadians, but also to promote a better understanding between Chinese people and the many ethnic groups of the Canadian society. FCCM is divided into four main divisions: the Markham Chinese Seniors Association, the Chinese Canadian Sports and Recreation Club of Markham, the Chinese Chamber of Commerce in Markham, and the Markham Chinese Cultural Centre.

The senior division organizes programs to meet the needs of the seniors, such as mah-jong, birthday parties, exercise classes, and excursions. The sports division organizes events like annual picnics, Christmas parties, regular badminton, basketball and dancing practice sessions, as well as operating the scouts section.

The business division concentrates on networking, disseminating information and organizing educational seminars for the business professionals. The cultural division is engaged in fostering cultural exchanges, and provide various cultural programs in addition to the teaching of english and chinese languages.

FCCM is also very much involved with the community, and welcomes the opportunity to work for its benefit through cooperation with charitable institutions such as United Way of York Region, Sunnybrook and Women's College Health Sciences centre, Markham Stouffville Hospital, and the Canadian Red Cross.

The year 2017-2018 has been a challenging year for FCCM in terms of community growth and development. Due to the demolition of Market Village Shopping Centre, FCCM has acquired the newly built King Square Shopping Centre as our new headquarters. We are currently in the process of finalizing the design and start construction. FCCM's Cultural Centre at Langham Square, 28 South Unionville Ave., allowed FCCM to make new connections in the growing community and develop strategies to better help our neighbours in the surrounding communities. Our determination to connect with the community has led us to help organize 16 events including two major events, Chinese New Year Han Gala and Taste of Asia Festival. Both events yielded remarkable success, with the Chinese New Year Han Gala having over eight-hundred guests, while the Taste of Asia had over 200,000 attendees. Along with our two major events, we also participated in the Markham Expo 150, China National Day Flag Raising Ceremony, TD Thanksgiving Carnival, The Belt and Road Business Forum, Chinese New Year celebration at various locations, and many more.

In the upcoming year, FCCM hopes to create a culturally connected community that celebrates the differences in cultures, and to better inform the community members about upcoming changes and events. As our Cultural Centre at King Square finishes in the upcoming months, we hope the community can enjoy our facilities and we can provide more space for cultural and interest classes as well as banquet space for special events.

FCCM will continue to work with our community partners in growth and development of new ways for everyone to enjoy the cultural mosaic in Canada.

I wish to take this opportunity to thank our board of directors, various committee members, staff and volunteers, and all who have given their time, support and advices in the past year. I look forward to working with you all to improve and advance our goals and services in the coming year.

Dr.Norman Bethune Memorial Garden Press Conference May 7, 2018






